

Whilst reflecting on the achievements, growth and progress of the Club in recent times, I must again acknowledge the efforts of our staff, under the management of John Tissott, our General Manager. I have the pleasure to confirm John's continued employment at the Club with our recent signing of another extension to his Contract. It is a privilege to work with John and all Club staff members.

Stage 3 of our Wet Pens development is underway with design approvals and work plans in progress. An existing waiting list is a very encouraging sign that we will achieve full occupancy of the new Pens almost as soon as they are completed early next year.

Some upgrades and modifications to existing Pens as well as improvements to the wash down bays and launch/retrieve ramp approaches are included in this development.

Landscaping across the northern shore area of the marina and around the Club grounds will enhance and beautify our facility. Please continue your boating activities and when moving your vehicles around the southern parking area while the work is in progress, keep watch for signage or direction that will ensure your safety and that of any worker in the area.

GENERAL MANAGER'S REPORT

The Club continues to prosper with growth in Membership coupled with increased demand for hardstand storage and wet pen accommodation. We are conducting our annual Open Day on Saturday 20th November from 10am to 2pm. Details are included elsewhere in this publication. It is important to continue to attract new Members to offset Members who do not renew their membership due to a change in their circumstances.

Western Lease Extension and Excision

This project has been completed and will benefit both the daily ramp users with additional trailer/towing vehicle secured bays and Members requiring hardstand boat storage on-site. The additional hardstand storage bays provided with this development have all been allocated to Members on an annual renewal basis resulting in a small wait list for Members requiring hardstand storage.

Parking - Colour Coding

Members are reminded that there are additional trailer/towing vehicle bays and car bays available in the new western lease extension area which is assessable from behind the clubhouse. Please note the parking bay colour coding which is marked on the traffic flow sign inside the main gate.

Access Road to Main Gate

We are working with our landlord (Department of Transport) to provide them with options to develop the DoT area outside our western boundary and main gate entry.

We are hopeful of improving the road to our main gate, avoid congestion and to provide organised parking for the public using the public toilets, beach, fishing off the northern groyne and for non-member guests.

Black Powder Coated Fence

Powder coating of our new and upgraded western boundary fence and gates has now been completed and is visually attractive and matches the colouring used elsewhere in the Woodman Point Regional Park. Our sincere thanks to Member Mark Wiese (CV Powder Coating) and to Tim Vlasschaert (MNG) who have both contributed significantly to this project.

Pens Stage 3 Project

I am still progressing with the planning and approvals for this project which includes new wet pens, additional parking, new rock seawall, landscaping and upgraded bitumen and water control for the washdown bays area. Completion of this project has been delayed to ~April 2022. The demand for these new pens has been unbelievable with the waiting list only one pen less than the total number of new pens available.

24/7 Ice Service - Payments

We have recently extended the payment options available to Members requiring block or crushed ice to cash or completion of an IOU slip. Please do the right thing and sort out payment before taking ice from the machine.

TREASURER'S REPORT

BY DES KELLY - TREASURER

The first Quarter Financial Results has continued to add to the strength shown in the past Financial Year with a surplus of \$42k. This was below last year's comparison figure of \$95k, primarily due to the non recurring \$52k Covid government subsidies received this time last year. It is pleasing to note that Member Subscriptions and Nomination Fees are strong with \$13k increase on this time last year. Membership numbers are up 18 in total (2% rise) comprising 6 Full members and 12 Social/Associate Members.

Management is very proactive during membership renewal time to encourage Full Members, who are contemplating non renewing their membership, to drop down to a social membership and so preserve their status if they feel that they may again upgrade to full sometime in the future.

This is especially the case if a Member sells their boat, or moves away for a short time and eventually returns to boating and would like to resume the benefits of membership. Under this scenario the Member is not required to again pay the Nomination fee and can simply rejoin as a Full Member.

Management is also active to contact Members who have not renewed to ensure they have received their renewals or to remind them to renew and avoid being struck off and access to the Club denied.

On the expenses side a major cost this quarter was incurred to remove the old rail lines on the boundary of the new and old parking areas of the Western extension of the car park. These steel rails had corroded and had risen above the pavement level, causing a possible trip hazard and tyre damage hazard when using the new car park. Repairs and maintenance was up \$10k on last year but only \$5k over budget due to the rail line removal and removal of a fire exit structure (\$1.4k) which had rusted out. Expenses were up \$6k on last year overall for the Quarter.

Improved Membership numbers and continuing support of the Hard Standing and Pen Storage facilities has enabled the Club to maintain its strong financial standing with cash at bank totaling \$208k and our Bank Facility of \$688k only drawn down at \$3k. This however will be drawn as the financial year progresses and we use the funds for our working capital requirements.

Capital expenditure this quarter has been primarily associated with the completion of the Western Extension of the car park, fencing upgrades, lighting and administration computer. \$15k.

The balance of the year capital is primarily budgeted for the Stage 3 pen project which is still in the planning stages and not yet at Management Committee approval stage. We will keep members abreast of this major project as milestones are reached.

Overall the Financial position continues to be strong with Net Assets having increased by \$42k for the Quarter. The weather is improving, the crays will soon be running and we can all get out on the water to enjoy our boating.


