VOLUNTEER INVOLVEMENT PROGRAM

Cockburn Power Boats operates on a strong business model, but at its heart is a Members Club. The Management Committee encourages new Members to engage in Club activities and functions to gain the maximum benefit from their membership.

Volunteering or attending functions and events gives new Members the opportunity to meet other Members, learn about Club features, and enjoy the social aspects of being a Club Member.

Following completion of the sign-off card, you will be ratified as a Full Member. As a new Member, you are required to attend four designated events within twelve months of your induction date. We are all 'time poor' and so have a variety of options available to suit most schedules.

Many Club events will be advertised as being an opportunity for new Members to sign off their volunteering commitment. Attend one of those events and a Management Committee Member, General Manager or Club Staff Member will endorse your sign-off card.

Events which may be endorsed include:

- Attending a busy bee, or assisting with administration overflow tasks;
- Attending the Annual General Meeting;
- Attending an event hosted by one of the special activity groups (Cruising, Fishing or Sailing);
- Attending and assisting with setup or pack up at other nominated events;
- Attending the Member's Bar, or
- Hosting a private function at the Club.

The Management Committee may also approve other actions that benefit the Club as being recognised.

Return the sign-off card once complete. You don't need to wait twelve months.

Please return your completed sign-off card to the Club office in person or by scanning and emailing. The card will be assessed by the Management Committee in considering your Full Membership.

Lost sign-off cards should be reported to the office ASAP.
