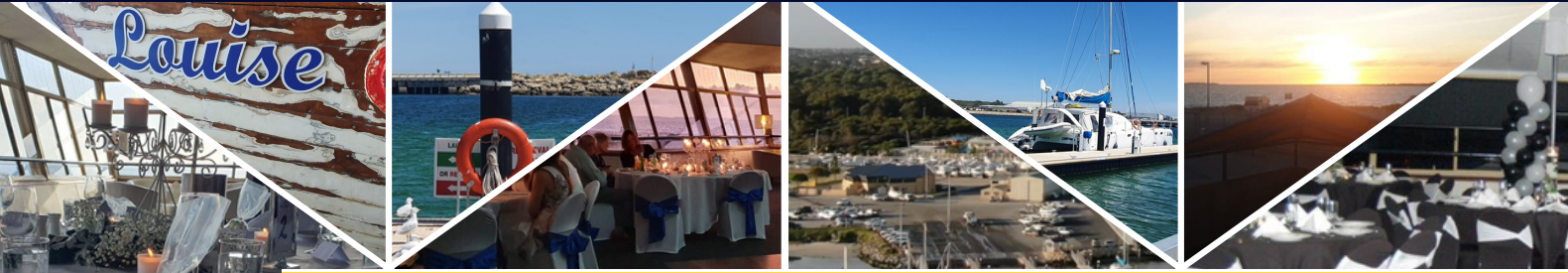

Yellowtail Kingfish Release - Members Invited to Attend

Recfishwest will be releasing 10,000 fingerlings at our boat ramps, 10am next Tuesday 9th August.

The release involves pumping all the fish from a large tank through a transparent hose into the ocean. Juvenile fish released through this program are marked to allow any fish captured in the future to be traced to this program.

Happy Friday Members,

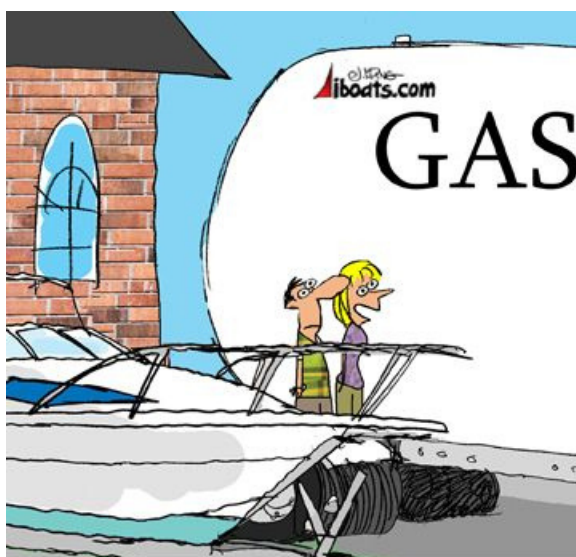
I hope you're all keeping well and staying warm in this crazy winter weather.
